Tube Light Bulbs

Wire Nuts

**Electrical Tape**

## **TOOLS LIST:**

Electric Drill & Screwdriver

Wood Router (if needed to make channel in back of wood)

Wire Cutter

Wire Stripper

- 1. Prepare wood base by painting or refinishing for the look you want.
- 2. Measure and mark where you want the wires in the wood.
- 3. Drill holes for wire as well as holes for ceiling mounting.
- 4. Cut wires to desired length for how long you would like each bulb to hang
- 5. Strip at least 1 inch of cloth and plastic coating on both black and white wires.
- 6. Disassemble the sockets. One at a time thread the wire through top of socket.
- 7. Attach black wire to copper screw and white wire to silver screw.
- 8. Reassemble socket and repeat with reaming sockets.
- 5. String wires through holes and staple wires into place on back side.
- 6. Cut 2-4 foot wire that will be attached into ceiling and strip both ends.
- 7. Join one end with all socket wire ends of black and white wires.
- 8. Twist copper together, add wire nut and use electrical tape to hold secure.
- 9. TURN OFF YOUR BREAKER!
- 10. Wire your other end of the 2-4 foot wire into the ceiling.
- 11. Mount wood onto ceiling with proper screws and anchors.
