





NOTES:

1. Cut crepe paper according to pattern.
SPEED TIP: If you are using a cutting machine, add PanPastel color to the petals while they are still altogether on the cutting mat, spreading the color with a paintbrush in a gradient.
2. Bend tip of wire and fill hole with white glue, then insert wire. Gently stretch black crepe center piece into a dome shape. Tap glue onto top of spun ball with your finger and pat the crepe center into place, making it smooth. At least half of your spun ball will be covered with the black crepe paper.
3. Trim one edge of center strip with pinking shears, scalloped rounded edges facing out. With a black marker, add a thin line of color to both sides of the pinked edge of strip, patting the edge rather than a straight line across for a more organic look. With detail scissors, create a fringe as thin as you can along full length of strip.
4. Use curling tool to shape fringe by gently rolling paper on the edge with your thumb. With fringe tips toward the center, glue fringe just below the center of the ball, covering the black crepe paper edge of the ball. Wrap a single time around and trim off excess with no gap between.
5. With the PanPastel side up, use curling tool to shape tips of petals curled down. Turn petal around and curl the wide side as well, only vary the shape with some curled up and some curled down.
6. Glue three smallest petals at base of flower's center in triangle, not going all the way down to the wire but just over the edge of the fringe and with PanPastel side up.
7. Glue the next three petals in rotation, offset about halfway overlapping from first three and down a little closer to the wire.
8. Glue the third set of three petals in the same rotation, offsetting while leaving a gap for the final set of petals, and affixing a bit closer to the wire.
9. Glue final set of petals in the space of the gap and all the way to the wire.
10. Fluff out the round of stamens in the middle away from the center. Adjust petal shapes to your liking. These flowers are not perfectly symmetrical; there will be variations in shape and curl.
11. Cut half-inch strips of either Juniper or Cypress crepe paper to wrap your wire stem with. Glue one end to the base of the flower. Then, working at about 1/4 of the stem at a time, add a stripe of white glue on the wire. Pull all the way for 100% stretch on the crepe as you wrap at a diagonal for a smooth wrap.
